Using the Wireless Network GTvisitor (Wireless for Visitors)

GTvisitor

GTvisitor is a commercial network providing wired and wireless internet access to any campus visitor. GTvisitor provides seamless wireless mobility throughout the campus, and is available at all wireless locations on the Atlanta and Savannah campuses, including the Georgia Tech Hotel and Conference Center. GTvisitor is operated by SageNet in partnership with Georgia Tech and the Georgia Tech Hotel and Conference Center.

Users in the Academy of Medicine: If you come up with a screen asking for a passcode while IN the Academy of Medicine building, this is by design. For GTvisitor use in the Academy of Medicine, contact the event coordinator for the Academy of Medicine.

GTvisitor has two tiers of service:

Free : Users are limited to 3Mbps/s data speed and does not come with any technical support.

Premium : Premium service comes with an increase in data speeds, technical support, and a public IP address. Premium services can be purchased from the portal or if you have a group of conference attendees that will all need premium service, passes can be purchased in increments of 1 day, 1 week, and 1 month. The duration of access is contiguous; and is not based on the amount of time the device is connected to the network. Once the user logs in, their access will expire after the amount of time associated with the account elapses, regardless of the activity of the user. GTvisitor passes which have not been used to login do not expire.

If you selected the "Free" option and discover that you require increased speeds and wish to purchase a pass for Premium service, you can navigate your browser to <http://4.5.6.7> to log out of your existing session.

Increased Speed Rates (for up to 10Mbps/s) for GTvisitor are as follows:

- \$3/day
- \$10/week
- \$30/month
